

Synopsis

Siglufjörður: an idyllically quiet fishing village in Northern Iceland, where no one locks their doors - accessible only via a small mountain tunnel. Ari Thór Arason: a rookie policeman on his first posting, far from his girlfriend in Reykjavik - with a past that he's unable to leave behind. When a young woman is found lying half-naked in the snow, bleeding and unconscious, and a highly esteemed, elderly writer falls to his death in the local theatre, Ari is dragged straight into the heart of a community where he can trust no one, and secrets and lies are a way of life. Rookie cop Ari Thóður Arason is so pleased to be offered a posting that he immediately accepts, even though it's in the tiny town of Siglufjörður, so far north it's closer to the Arctic than to Reykjavik. A place, so they say, where nothing ever happens. So when an elderly writer falls down a flight of stairs to his death everyone assumes it's an accident, and when Ari Thóður is reluctant to accept this, he is quickly warned off by his boss Támas. But when a young woman is found unconscious in the snow and bleeding from a knife wound, even Támas has to face up to the fact that crime has arrived in Siglufjörður. This is described in the blurb as a 'debut', but I think it's actually the second in a series although the first to be translated. There are references to what sounds like a previous story involving Ari Thóður and his girlfriend Kristín, but this one works fine on its own and doesn't give any major spoilers for the earlier book, should it ever appear. The writing is excellent, and enhanced by a fine translation by Quentin Bates, who is himself a highly regarded crime writer. Jónasson slowly builds up a claustrophobic feeling to this small fishing community, approachable only by air or through a tunnel under the mountains, both of which routes become impossible as the winter snows deepen. Ari Thóður finds himself feeling more and more cut off, emotionally as well as physically, especially since Kristín hasn't forgiven him for accepting the posting without discussing it with her.
