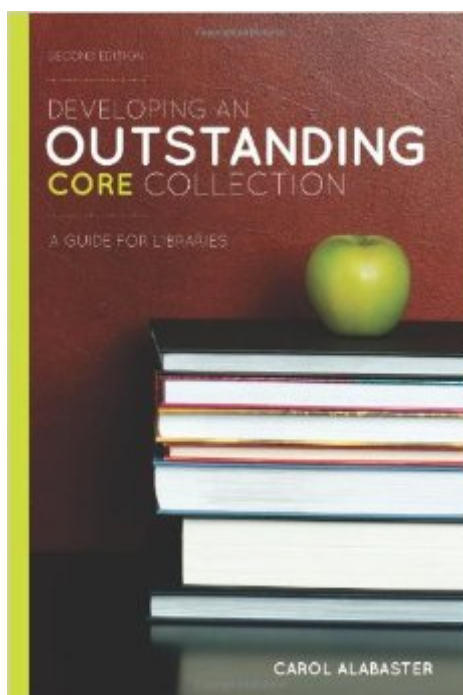


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Developing An Outstanding Core Collection: A Guide For Libraries, Second Edition
